Top in-house counsel recognised at the tenth annual Lexology and International Law Office European Counsel Awards in association with the Association of Corporate Counsel.

John Harrison of Airbus Group was named General Counsel of the Year after receiving multiple individual nominations from colleagues and partners at leading law firms. One respondent enthused:

“John leads by example and he exemplifies what it means to be a leading General Counsel of a multi-national company in an interconnected world.”
